SEND CHRISTMAS CARDS TO CHRISTIAN PRISONERS

As you prepare to write Christmas cards to family and friends, we'd like to encourage you to also send a card to a Christian prisoner of conscience in China or Pakistan.

Pastor Li Juncai has been serving a five-and-a-half-year sentence in China since November 2019 for objecting to the forced removal of the cross from his church. Cards for Pastor Juncai can be sent to the prison where he is being held.

Shagufta Kiran has been in prison in Pakistan since July 2021 and was sentenced to death for blasphemy in September 2024. The address for Shagufta is c/o The Edge Foundation, a Church in Chains partner.

What do I need to remember when writing my card?

Keep to a simple Christmas greeting as the content of your card will have to be translated. DON'T make any criticism of the government DON'T mention Church in Chains (or any similar organisation) DON'T refer to their arrest or sentence DON'T include your address

When is the latest date for posting for Christmas?

Thursday 5 December is the official date but please do post your card any time before Christmas.
